Mark Salzer is Director and Principal Investigator of the UPENN Collaborative on Community Integration of Individuals with Psychiatric Disabilities and is an Associate Professor in the Department of Psychiatry at the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine.

Dr. Salzer also has been Principal Investigator on other federally-funded grants (NIH, SAMHSA) and Co-Investigator in other NIDRR funded efforts, including the Matrix/Penn RRTC on Work and Serious Mental Illness (1994-2001). He is a faculty member and mentor in the NIDRR-funded UMDNJ postdoctoral training program on psychiatric rehabilitation.

He has published more than 55 articles and book chapters on topics including self-help groups, peer-delivered services, employment issues, and empowerment. He is an editor of Psychiatric Rehabilitation in Practice: A CPRP Preparation and Skills Workbook, published by the United States Psychiatric Rehabilitation Association. (Columbia, MD.) He is also an Associate Editor for the Administration and Policy in Mental Health and on the Editorial Board for the Psychiatric Rehabilitation Journal. He is the Director of Evaluation and Research at Horizon House, Inc. and the Mental Health Association of Southeastern Pennsylvania.
