Research-Based Principles of Successful Vocational Rehabilitation Strategies: Are These Available in Your Area?

- 1. People with serious mental illness can be successfully engaged in competitive employment.
- 2. Vocational rehabilitation services should involve employment in integrated settings for minimum wage or above.
- 3. Consumers should be placed in paid jobs as quickly as possible and according to their preferred pace.
- 4. Ongoing vocational support should be available as needed and desired.
- 5. Consumers should be helped to find jobs that match their career preferences.
- Solution vocational rehabilitation services should explicitly address financial planning and provider education/support around disability benefits and entitlements.
- Vocational and mental health services should be integrated and coordinated.
- Vocational service providers should work collaboratively with consumers to address issues of stigma and discrimination, and to help negotiate reasonable accommodations with employers.
- Vocational rehabilitation services should be made available to all mental health consumers.
- 10. Vocational services should involve family and friends in supporting consumers' efforts to work.
