Diabetic Eye Disease

Finding and treating eye problems early can help save your sight.

Tell your eye doctor about any eye problems you're having.

Diabetic eye disease (also called diabetic retinopathy) is a serious problem that can lead to loss of sight.

Signs that you may have eye problems

- ⇒ blurred vision or seeing spots
- ⇒ seeing rings around lights, dark spots, or flashing lights
- ⇒ pain in your eyes

What can I do?

- Keeping your <u>blood sugar</u> normal can prevent or delay eye disease.
- Keeping your <u>blood pressure</u> under control is also important.

Visit your eye doctor at least once a year!
