

Recognizing Bladder or Kidney Infections

If you have a bladder or kidney infection, you'll be given medicine to stop the infection.

It's critical to take all the medicine as prescribed.

Bladder and kidney infections can damage your kidneys.

Call your doctor right away if you have the **signs of what may be a bladder infection:**

- Feel like urinating more often than usual
- Cloudy or bloody urine
- Pain or burning when you urinate

Call your doctor right away if you have the **signs of what may be a kidney infection:**

- Pain on either side (or both sides) of your back
- Back pain with chills and fever
- Not being able to urinate
