Glipizide (Glucotrol)	 Always take with meals Your nurse will tell you when and how much to take, if you are prescribed Glipizide 	⇒ Low blood sugar⇒ Diarrhea/nausea⇒ Dizziness/headache
Actos (Pioglitazone)	 Always take with meals Your nurse will tell you when and how much to take, if you are prescribed Actos 	⇒ Weight gain⇒ Headache⇒ Joint pain
Metformin (Glucophage)	 Always take with meals Your nurse will tell you when and how much to take, if you are prescribed Metformin 	 ⇒ Diarrhea ⇒ Nausea/vomiting ⇒ Headache ⇒ Rash
